I would like to get your feedback regarding this approach because now we have Hero, school reporting can be done in different ways:

- It can be done traditionally with a written report in Term 2 and Term 4; or
- We can use Hero to report regular progress for subject areas; Reading, Writing and Mathematics, curriculum and key competencies across the year without the written reports; or
- A combination of Hero reporting regular progress and a final end of year written report.

I will then consider your feedback, alongside the teachers' feedback, in shaping how school reporting is done in the future at Limehills School.


